- The primary duty is to ensure that knowledge of DKE Standards and Health & Safety Policy is known and followed by all members of the chapter.
- Act as the chapter leader for upholding the values and principles of Delta Kappa Epsilon.
 - Assume responsibility for empowering members to hold each other accountable for their actions
 - In charge of reinforcing these ideas before and during any organization events, especially those of the social kind.
- Is a role model in the areas of standards, ideals, and attitudes
- Review and fully explain DKE's Fraternity Standards so that all members have a clear understanding of its intent
- Is proactive and reviews standards for expected behavior before social functions and special events
- Shares responsibility with Brother Beta and the New Member Educator to ensure completion of TightRope requirements.
- Serve as a member of the Executive Board
- Develop and adhere to his own risk management plan
- Develop and make all aware of a Crisis Management Plan
 - Include how the chapter will address major alcohol violations, drugs, sexual assault allegations, death, suicide, serious injuries, etc.
 - Include chain of command and contact list of advisors, association, university officials, DKE International, parents, all brothers' information, police, fire, university counseling services, etc.
- Serve as the chair of the Health & Safety Committee
 - Create and oversee a Health & Safety committee that will help prepare for events, review plans/actions of the chapter and members and hold people accountable to policy.

- Review excuses for not attending chapter events with the Exec Board and jointly determine if the excuse is permitted; notify members if their excuse is excused or unexcused
- Work with the Corresponding Secretary to help complete the section of the Lion Trophy application about Risk Management.
- Maintain a relationship with your Chapter Consultant
 - In the event of a non-medical emergency issue, they should be the first person contacted
- Member of the Standards Board
- Schedule all Standards Board meetings with the Vice President
- Provide seminars on issues related to health and safety including, but not limited to, alcohol, drugs, sexual misconduct, sexual health, mental health, hazing, nutrition, and self-care.
- Review marketing materials and t-shirt designs prior to them being printed and review of party themes
 - Any t-shirt that has DKE letters or other insignia must be approved by Headquarters
